- (c) **RW** where the River Wharf is located in Barbuda (1 mark)

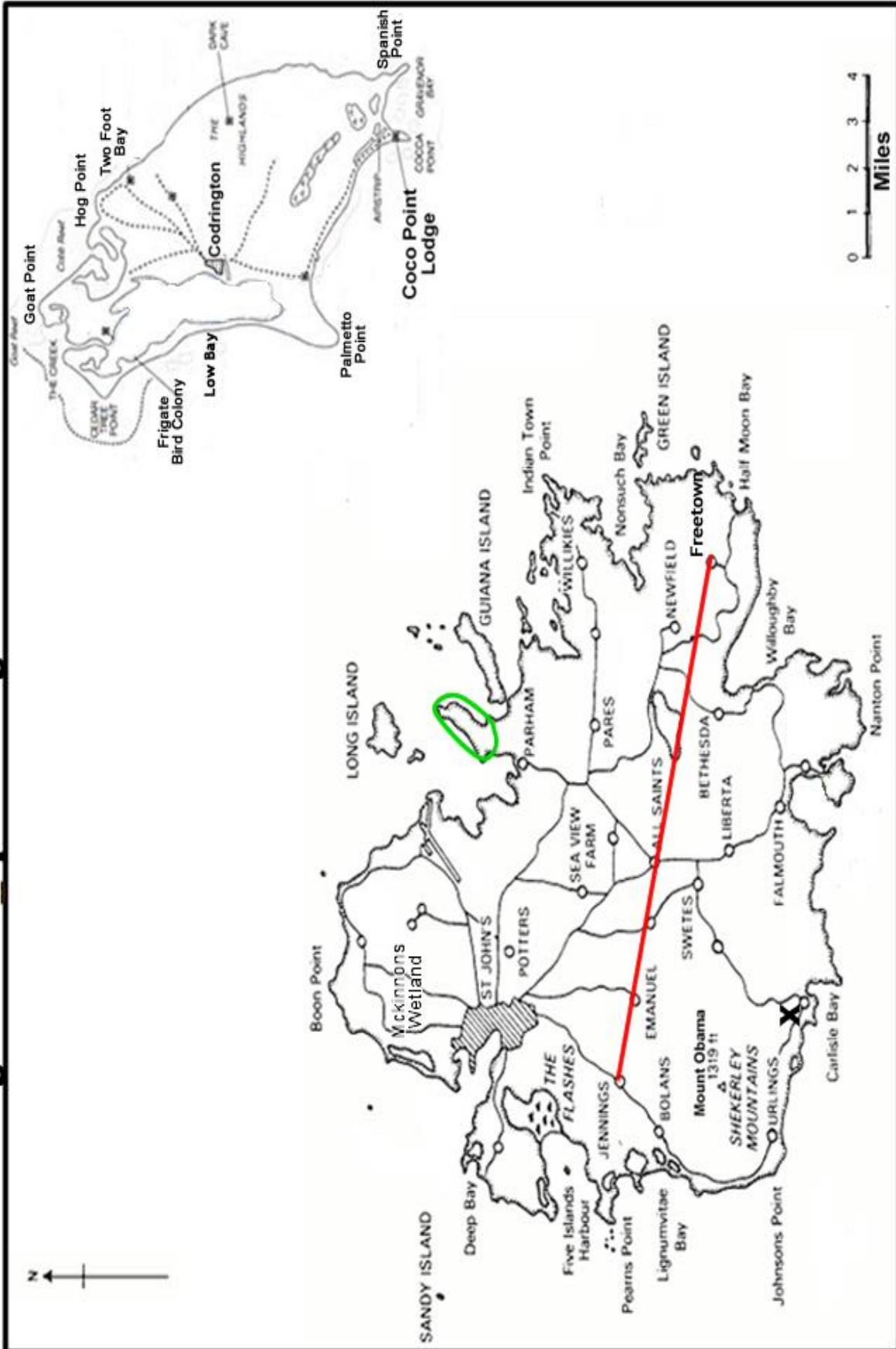
2. Name:
