The principal was concerned with students' poor performance on School-Based Assessments and the parents' beliefs that teachers did not have adequate knowledge of research. She made a request for the Ministry of Education to conduct a survey to determine the reason for the poor performance. A sample of 200 students was chosen for the survey. The survey revealed that 60% of the students were undernourished, 20% could not afford books, 15% had too many household chores to do before and after school, and 5% were not interested in school work. The findings were presented to the principal and recommendations were made.


